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Cantonese had lost its medials sometime ago in its history, reducing the ability for speakers to distinguish its sibilant initials. In modern-day Hong Kong, many younger speakers do not distinguish between certain phoneme pairs such as /n/ vs. /l/ and /ŋ/ vs. the null initial and merge one sound into another.
